Annual General Meeting

Each year, the Woodworkers of the Southern Peninsula hold its AGM on the second Wednesday in August. Because of Melbourne's ongoing COVID19 restrictions, the August AGM could not be held. Under the

Associations Incorporation Act 2012 (the Act) the last practical date for the 2020 AGM is 30th November 2020, we can also request an extension of time if required.

If there is an earlier opportunity to hold the 2020 AGM in person, by ZOOM, or other means this will be announced as soon as we are free to do so. A firm date for the 2020 AGM will determine the due date for payment of 2020/21 membership fees. All members must be financial to be eligible to attend the AGM and to vote at the Election, on other issues or to attend the Club should we be able to open.

Again members will be kept informed in good time.

Until there is a resolution to the AGM the current Committee will manage the Club as required.
