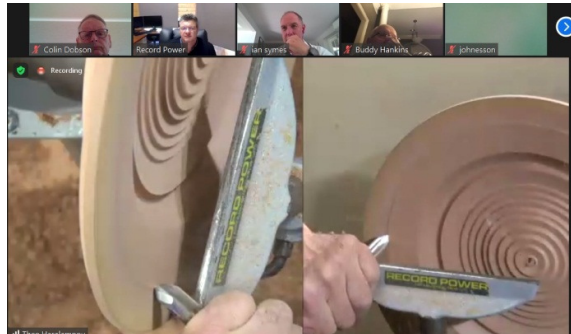
Theo Haralampou (live from QLD) conducts the Woodturning session and provides plenty of interesting tips.

On Saturday 17th Oct 2020 Theo turned an Elegant Platter. The session lasted 2 hours. After fixing a PC problem I logged into the demonstration half way through it & thought it was very well organised

Some things I picked up were: he uses more than one camera to show what he was demonstrating.

He sprays on methylated spirits to lift the grain enabling a smoother finish.

Besides the 2 standard cameras he uses a boom arm & a Go-Pro 7. He also demonstrated how he uses a light & shadows to do duplicate more than one turned item.
