

History

The 'Club' as it is known, was formed in 1996 from a wood working group run by the University of the third age. It met first in a school classroom then moved to a small shed on Shire land. It expanded rapidly and a garage was added, donated by a member. When this too became overcrowded, financial assistance was obtained from Mornington Peninsula Shire Council. With this grant and a substantial contribution from club funds, together with members' labour, the original clubhouse was opened by the Mayor in February 2003. The original sheds were erected as storage sheds next to the clubhouse. Equipment and furniture had been progressively upgraded.

The Present

The club is well equipped, runs teaching and working sessions. See activities overleaf. The club is managed by an elected committee. It is a non-profit, autonomous, self-funding and self-governing Club. The Club is registered with Consumer Affairs Victoria as an Incorporated Association and is fully insured. The Club engages in community activities, including an annual distribution of toys to needy children of the Mornington Peninsula through selected charities.

The Club relocated to its current location at 66B Elizabeth Ave, Capel Sound in June 2019.
